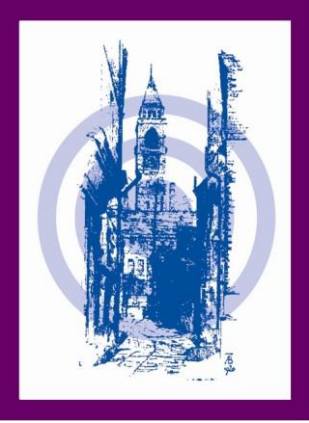

As part of the Society's contribution to Wakefield Lit Fest, we have arranged a special screening of another 1960s' classic film, *A Taste of Honey*.

Following on from our previous screenings of *Kes* (filmed in and around Barnsley), *This Sporting Life* (Wakefield), we move over the Pennines for our latest film. Set in Salford, *A Taste of Honey* explores attitudes towards class, race, gender and sexuality against a backdrop of an industrial north.

Released in 1961, the film stars Dora Bryan, Rita Tushingham and Murray Melvyn. It is based on the play by Shelagh Delaney and directed by Tony Richardson. Tushingham and Melvyn went on to receive Best Actress and Actor awards at the 1962 Cannes Film Festival for their performances.
